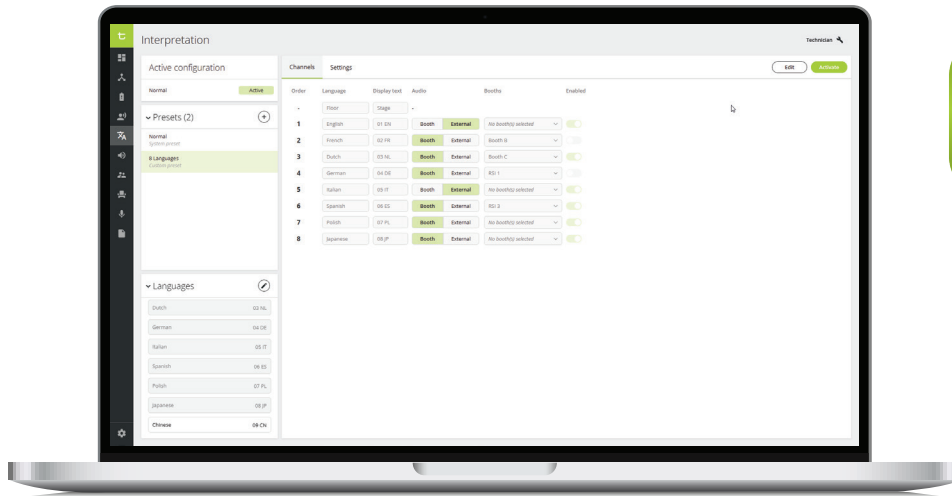


# Confero Advanced Interpretation



## Description

### Confero Overview

Confero is Televic's solution for effortless meeting management, operating directly via the web server integrated into the Plixus central unit (Plixus AE-R or Plixus MME). Designed with simplicity and reliability in mind, its interpretation functionality includes a built-in default configuration that ensures smooth, efficient and immediate operation.

### Advanced Interpretation License

The Confero Advanced Interpretation license is designed for use with Televic's Lingua interpreter desks (ID or Lingua ID-MM). It provides advanced configuration, control, and monitoring capabilities for interpretation channels and interpreter booths in multilingual meeting environments.

### Extended Interpretation Capabilities

The Confero Advanced Interpretation license unlocks a range of enhanced features beyond the standard default configuration. Multiple custom interpretation configurations can be created and switched easily, and you can save and recall presets. In combination with the Confero Advanced Audio license, the number of configurable interpretation channels is increased from 11 to up to 48. In addition, the display labels for the Floor channel and interpretation channels can be customized, and a global language list can also be defined and reused across custom configurations.

Here you can define a global language list that can be used across all interpretation presets.

The license offers full control over audio configuration. For each interpretation channel, Technicians can select internal or external audio routing, assign a specific interpreter booth, and enable or disable the channel as needed.

### User Roles and Access Control

In line with the Confero 360 license, role-based access ensures that each user has access only to the tools relevant to their responsibilities. When the Confero Advanced Interpretation license is active, Technicians can create and edit multiple interpretation configurations in addition to the default configuration. When used together with the Confero 360 license, Operators and Chairpersons can view the active interpretation configuration and control the microphones of the Lingua Interpreter Desks. This is configurable via the role permissions.

### Installation and Accessibility

Installation is quick and straightforward. The license is activated directly via the web interface of the Plixus central unit, accessible through any standard web browser. Confero is platform-independent and can be used on Windows and macOS systems without the need for additional software installation.

## Features & Benefits

With the Confero Advanced Interpretation license, you can:

- » Use the default interpretation configuration
- » Create new custom interpretation configurations, either from the existing default preset or from scratch
- » Activate a prepared interpretation configuration
- » Edit, duplicate and delete a configuration
- » Switch between existing configurations
- » Configure from 11 to 48 language channels (Confero Advanced Audio license required)
- » Create a global and reusable language list
- » Edit the display text for the Floor and language channels
